Key Concepts

3 Lesson

- Read Romans 12:6.
- Talk to the children about things that they like to do. (games, read, playing, etc.)
- Now think about things that we like to do for others.
- How does God use the things that we like to do to help others?
- · God has given each one of us gifts.
- Do we all like to visit the elderly?
 - No. But some of us do.
- Do we all like to read stories?
 - No. But God gave some of us the love of reading.
- We can use these gifts to serve Him.
- · God gives all of us different gifts and wants us to use these gifts to help other people.
- He wants us to use our gifts to teach other people about Him.
- When you grow up and get a job, what are some of the things you think you would like to do?
 - Make a list
 - How does God use these jobs to help others learn about Him?
- God wants us to do the things that we are good at.
 - When we do these things the best way we can, we are using the gifts that God has given us.
- Read Romans 12:6 again.
 - God has given all of us special gifts.
