1 Key Concepts

- · God's grace in Christ leads to a response of joy and generosity.
- · Teach the students the importance of doing servant events.
- · Teach the students the importance of being a good neighbor.

2 Teacher Preparation

- · Be ready to read 2 Corinthians 8:1-5.
- · Be ready to do some brainstorming with the students on a servant event.

3 Lesson

- · Read the story of the Macedonians in 2 Corinthians 8:1-5.
- · In this story, the Macedonians care for others.
 - God's grace empowered them.
 - They gave even though they were poor.
 - They begged for the opportunity to give.
 - They gave themselves first to the Lord.
 - Then they gave themselves to their neighbors.
- · Our neighbors are not just those who live near us.
 - They are the person you are sitting next to, or the person you pass on the street.
 - They could be the person you see in church or someone on the other side of the world.
 - They don't need to be people we know.
- · God wants us to take care of and help all those in need.
- · God says in Acts 20:35 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'
 - Look for ways to help your neighbors.
 - Look for ways to help those around us.
- · God says in 2 Corinthians 8:1-5 to be joyful and to share generously.
