  - What are some ways we can be a good neighbor to people in our school?
  - Write them down.
- · What are some ways we can be a good neighbor in our church?
  - Write them down.

  - Write them down.
- · Talk to the children about doing a servant event.
  - Being a helper in your school, church or community is what God wants us to be doing.
